

The Clatterbridge Abseil is an event wholly owned and operated by Clatterbridge Cancer Charity, Registered Charity Number: 1202412.

By taking part in The Clatterbridge Abseil, you are agreeing to donate to or fundraise for Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.

Clatterbridge Cancer Charity are the only Charity represented at The Clatterbridge Abseil.

By participating in The Clatterbridge Abseil, you agree to abide by the rules, instructions or regulations displayed or given before or on the day of The Clatterbridge Abseil by Clatterbridge Cancer Charity, the police and/or The Clatterbridge Abseil officials.

The Clatterbridge Abseil is non-competitive, non-timed abseil for supporters of Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.

Clatterbridge Cancer Charity will endeavour to ensure that materials provided are available to all participants, however this cannot be guaranteed. Materials include event t-shirts and medals, and anything other provided by the Charity for the abseil.

By taking part in The Clatterbridge Abseil, you agree to appear in photographs taken by the event photographer for being used to promote both Clatterbridge Cancer Charity and The Clatterbridge Abseil in the future. Should you wish to not appear in any promotional material you must contact Clatterbridge Cancer Charity at the earliest opportunity.

By taking part in The Clatterbridge Abseil, you agree that you will abide by the instructions and rules set by the abseil management company, Big Bang Promotions.

By taking part in The Clatterbridge Abseil you are representing Clatterbridge Cancer Charity on the event and therefore agree, to abide by the rules of the event at all times.

By registering, you understand that refunds are not available – places however can be transferred to another participant at the discretion of the Charity.

Should we need to change the date of The Clatterbridge Abseil, we will notify you of this change as soon as possible. Your The Clatterbridge Abseil event place will be automatically transferred to the re-scheduled The Clatterbridge Abseil or you will be eligible for a refund if you are no longer able to attend. This must be communicated to Clatterbridge Cancer Charity at the earliest opportunity.

In the event of The Clatterbridge Abseil being cancelled, we will notify you at the earliest opportunity and you can either request a refund, or donate your registration payment to Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.

In the event of any issues with your participation, you may transfer this to another person but this must be done within at least 10 working days of the event itself and is at the discretion of the Charity.

All event packs will be made available from within 3 months of the event date and can either be posted to you (this must be requested) or collected from Clatterbridge Liverpool or Wirral, Monday-Friday.

Event entries will close if we reach capacity.

Event registration on the day is possible should the event not be sold out.

Event details are subject to change e.g. start time, and as such, participants should check the Charity social media channels and website, and look out for any communications ahead of The Clatterbridge Abseil.

All registrations received cover the cost of running the event for Clatterbridge Cancer Charity, with all fundraising going towards the work of Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.

Participants must understand that they will be entering an operational setting in The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre and must remain with staff members at all times.

Participants must be respectful of those within The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre when abseiling past.

We request that pets are not brought to the event (except service dogs), due to the number of participants on the day it is in the best interests of all concerned to ensure the safety of all participants.

Lost property – Clatterbridge Cancer Charity will gather any lost property discovered and keep it within their Clatterbridge Wirral office for a period of 1 month beyond the event date, should any items not be collected they will then be disposed of.

Participants must refrain from drinking alcohol prior to or during the event. If it is suspected that a participant has been drinking alcohol or taking recreational drugs, participation will be refused and no refunds given.

We ask all participants along with their supporters not to use aggressive or abusive language towards Clatterbridge Cancer Charity and Big Bang Promotions staff, volunteers, officials, and other participants. You should also avoid behaving in a way that may cause injury or harm to other participants and/or spectators, or which may cause offence or damage the reputation of Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.

Spectators are not permitted to enter the venue with participants. Everyone entering The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre for the purposes of the abseil must be a registered participant.

We reserve the right to ask participants and supporters to leave The Clatterbridge Abseil if they do not adhere to these rules, and no refunds shall be given in these circumstances.

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are fit and healthy to take part, anyone unsure of their ability to complete the route should speak with their GP / consultant.

Participant Restrictions

- a. Participants cannot take part if they are:
 - I. Pregnant
 - II. Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs
 - III. Under 16 years old
- b. For participants with any of the following they must seek professional medical advice before participating and sign a non-standard waiver
 - I. Aged 50 years or above
 - II. High blood pressure
 - III. Heart condition
 - IV. Suffer from dizziness or epilepsy

- V. Damage to neck, back, spinal column, legs or eyes
 - VI. Asthma
 - VII. Prescribed Medication, this must be disclosed at registration to inform us of how this may affect you.
- c. The following points apply to ALL participants.
- I. Participants aged 16 and 17 years old require a parent or guardian to be present, sign permission and will be required to complete a non-standard waiver
 - II. Glasses and hard contact lenses cannot be worn
 - III. Maximum weight limit for a solo participant is 120kg (18.9 stone)
 - IV. Waist harnesses fit waist size of 40cm (15.7 inches) to 125cm (49.2 inches)
- d. Big Bang Promotions reserve the right to prevent any participant from taking part in the activity if they deem them unfit to partake.
